

Bend Trap Club Membership Information

There are 6 classes of memberships: Life, Associate, Tournament, Sheriff, Probationary General and General. All membership classes (except Life, Tournament and Sheriff) carry the same dues. **All BTC members in good standing as of August of 2007 were automatically placed in the General membership class.** All **new** memberships begin as Associate members. All memberships (regardless of class) are considered as "Family". A Family member may be any person of the Member's immediate family, consisting of a spouse and any children under the age 18 who resides in the Member's residence. **Only Life and General Members are entitled to vote on club matters of business.** A copy of the current club bylaws is available to any member. More specific membership class information is included on the back of this announcement. Any additional questions may be directed to the Bend Trap Club Board of directors (contact information on web site).

BTC membership dues are **\$40** for Associate, Probationary General and General. The Tournament (1 week) membership is **\$1** per week. The annual membership dues period is January-December, making the next yearly dues payable in December. According to the club bylaws, a Member must have his dues paid and be in good standing prior to the annual meeting date (usually in March) in order to retain membership status. Should a current General or Probationary class member neglect to pay dues within the time period allowed, subsequent application to the club will be as an Associate class Member.

Shooting periods are scheduled on Thursday and Sunday mornings for trap. Practice trap rounds for members are \$4.00 each. Special rates apply for juniors (< 18 years old). Members receive an additional 10% shooting card bonus for purchases of \$40 or more for targets. Please fill out the Membership/Renewal application (**note email address if available**), sign and return. Application cards that are not signed will be rejected and returned for signature.

MEMBERSHIP CLASSES

Members and Classes. The Club has four active classes of Members: General Member, Probationary Member, Associate Member and Life Member. All memberships are assumed to be "Family". A Family member may be any person of the Member's immediate family consisting of a spouse and any children under the age 18 who resides in the Member's residence. Application to the Probationary or the General membership class must be made to and approved by a majority of the Board of Directors. The membership terms and conditions and rights of each Member class are as follows:

A. GENERAL MEMBER

- (1) To use the clubhouse and grounds and to attend Club activities; and
- (2) To extend the use of the clubhouse and grounds, and entrance to Club activities to their guests upon such terms and conditions as may be established from time to time by the Board of Directors; and
- (3) To have the right to vote on all matters permitted by Members of nonprofit corporations as provided under Oregon law; and
- (4) Must have been a prior Probationary General member in good standing for the prior year; and
- (5) The total number of General Memberships is limited to 100 persons

B. PROBATIONARY GENERAL MEMBER

- (1) To use the clubhouse and grounds and to attend club activities; and
- (2) To extend the use of the clubhouse and grounds, and entrance to Club activities to their guests upon such terms and conditions as may be established from time to time by the Board of Directors; and
- (3) Must have been a prior Associate Member in good standing; and
- (4) Must be recommended by a majority of the Board of Directors; and
- (5) No restriction on number of Probationary Membership persons

C. ASSOCIATE MEMBER

- (1) To use the clubhouse and grounds and to attend club activities; and
- (2) To extend the use of the clubhouse and grounds, and entrance to Club activities to their guests upon such terms and conditions as may be established from time to time by the Board of Directors; and
- (3) No restriction on number of Associate Membership persons

D. LIFE MEMBER

- (1) To have all the rights of a General Member; and
- (2) To extend the use of the clubhouse and grounds, and entrance to Club activities to their guests upon such terms and conditions as may be established from time to time by the Board of Directors; and
- (3) The designation of a Life Member shall be presented by nomination of a majority vote of the Board of Directors. The nominations shall become effective upon approval by vote of the majority of the club members eligible to vote at the annual meeting; and
- (4) A Life membership shall be nontransferable.

E. SHERIFF MEMBER

- (1) To use the clubhouse and grounds and to attend club activities; and
- (2) To extend the use of the clubhouse and grounds, and entrance to Club and activities to their guests upon such terms and conditions as may be established from time to time by the Board of Directors; and
- (3) Class membership requires being a certified police officer as designated by the Deschutes County Sheriff's Office

F. TOURNAMENT MEMBER

- (1) To use the clubhouse and grounds and to attend club activities; and
- (2) To extend the use of the clubhouse and grounds, and entrance to Club activities upon such terms and conditions as may be established from time to time by the Board of Directors; and
- (3) No restriction on number of Tournament Membership persons
- (4) Membership Duration is limited to period noted on application

Voting Rights of Members. Each General and Life Membership shall be entitled to one vote on issues submitted to a vote by the Board of Directors. Family of Members shall not be entitled to vote.

The above signed further agrees to release from liability and to indemnify and hold harmless the Bend Trap Club and any of the directors, officers or agents, from any and all claims (including costs and attorney fees) that the above signed may now have or may hereafter have for property damage, personal injury or death, which the above signed may suffer or for which the above signed may be liable to others arising out of or in any way connected with the above signed's shooting activities at the trap club facilities. This assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnity Agreement shall apply to all claims based upon negligence and any other theory of recovery except claims based upon willful or intentional misconduct.
