### **2010 Membership Dues**

The calendar year is drawing to an end and with it comes our dues renewal process. The annual membership dues period is January-December, making the 2010-year dues payable by December 31, 2009. After much discussion and evaluation of the last 1.5 years of expenses, the directors have decided that the dues and shooting fees must be adjusted. Dues will now be **\$40** for a 2010 club membership. All practice shooting rounds will be \$4 (Junior shooting remains at \$2) effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010. Card target purchases of \$40 or more will receive an additional 10% shooting credit at time of purchase. More details of the club expense/income summaries will be available at the annual meeting. Shooting periods are currently Thursday and Sunday for trap and skeet.

Please fill out the enclosed Membership/Renewal application (note email address if available), sign and return to club's address. There is a small survey on the form asking your preference for practice shooting days. In order to retain general membership status, you must have your dues paid by **March 8th, 2010**. Should a current Member neglect to pay dues within the time period allowed, subsequent application to the club will be as an Associate class Member.

### **2010 Annual Meeting**

The annual meeting, per the club bylaws, is to be held on the second Sunday of March. **The meeting is scheduled for March 14, 2010 at 1:30pm.** The meeting will be held at the Bend Trap Club Clubhouse. In accordance with club bylaws, a general member must have his dues paid, renewal application completed, and be in good standing by March 8<sup>th</sup> 2010 in order to vote in the 2010 annual general membership meeting. **All members**, regardless of membership class, are welcome to attend and participate.

The meeting agenda will cover the State of the Club, officer reports, election of board members, club status, proposed development activities and other BTC business as brought before the board by the membership. Please try to attend if possible as this is an important meeting for the club.

### **2010 Turkey/Prize Fun Shoot**

The club has a Turkey/Prize shoot on **December 19th (Saturday)**. Several items to note about these "fun" shoots. These are the club's annual fund raising events that help offset the costs for sponsoring youth shooting and other club activities. As started last year, we're continuing the prize guarantee that if you can't win a prize after 5 rounds, you can turn your shooting card in for a prize anyway; everybody can be a winner (fine print details at the club or see flyer). Bring your friends as everybody has a great chance to win a prize. Food, ammunition and a few loaner shotguns will be available at the club. The bacon buster will be there as well to offer a bit more challenge. This year's prizes include turkeys, gift cards(!) and shotgun shells. The grocery gift cards allow you to buy your own meat, or get the rest of the dinner fix'ngs and dessert; a lot less work and you can combine the cards to get more buying power.

### **Directions:**

Take Highway 20 east toward Burns. Travel east past the Millican store approximately 4 miles.
