NOTICE: OSTA ANNUAL MEETING

Friday, June 14, 2024 immediately following the shoot-offs.

An important item of business is a proposed OSTA Bylaw change required as a result of this 2022 PITA Bylaw change.

Section E, Item 1, letter a.: Have no fewer than three (3) Officers duly elected from the membership. Those offices shall include, but are not limited to President, Secretary and Treasurer.

PROPOSED OSTA CHANGE.

BY-LAWS OF THE OREGON STATE TRAPSHOOTING ASSOCIATION

Section 2, paragraph 2: Add item in bold:

At the annual meeting held each year during the State tournament the membership shall elect three directors to serve for three years. A total of nine (9) directors shall constitute the officers of the Association. These nine (9) directors shall elect one director to serve as President, one director as Vice President, one director as Treasurer **and one director as Secretary**, all of whom serve for one year. This election shall occur within forty-eight hours following the annual membership meeting.

Delete Section 2, paragraph 3: which states

A Secretary shall be employed under terms and conditions set by the Board of Directors. The Secretary, while employed by the OSTA, shall not be a voting member of the Board.

HANDICAPPING & SQUADDING

The handicap table/cashier office will be open Wednesday, June 12, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. and Thursday-Sunday at 7:30 a.m.

HANDICAPPING

PITA rules will govern this shoot. It is the shooter's responsibility to show both PITA and ATA average cards to determine handicap yardage assignment.

REGISTRATION AND CROSS-REGISTRATION

All targets in the program will be registered with the PITA. \$4 PITA daily fee/\$2 per 100 OSTA fee. Targets may be cross-registered with the ATA, subject to all the fees, rules and requirements.

PRACTICE

Open daily at 8 a.m. - \$6/round.
Those booking a minimum of 4 nights RV receive two complimentary practice rounds, excludes dry campers.

ALLSTAR NOTICE

If you cannot attend the Bend PITA Shoot in April but do shoot the HAA events at the Oregon State Shoot and either the Grand Pacific or Fall Classic it will count as 2 major events and 2 clubs. No Club can be counted 3 times.

RULES

By entering this competition, every shooter agrees to accept all official decisions and abide by PITA rules. It is the responsibility of each shooter to know the rules governing this competition. Copies of the current PITA rules are available at the handicap table.

REFUNDS

No entry fees, purses, or options will be refunded after an event has started

RETURNED CHECKS

A \$25 fee will be charged for any checks returned.

PAYOUT CHECKS

No payouts will be made during the shoot.
The OSTA will mail checks within 7 days of the end of the shoot.

TARGETS/TRAPS

White Flyer Orange Dome pitch targets, PAT traps and wired voice calls will be used.

TROPHIES

Sub-Category and Out-of-State trophies vary by event. No shooter shall be eligible to win more than one trophy per event, except YES team trophies. OSTA reserves the right to change the trophy package in whole or in part as may become necessary.

Please pick up your trophies as soon as possible following each event.

Delivery arrangements for trophies left behind after the shoot must be made and paid for by the recipient.

YOUTH ENTRY

If you would like all winnings sent to your Oregon College Saving Plan please provide form at registration.

PROGRAM CHANGES

The Oregon State Trapshooting Association reserves the right to change this program in whole or in part as may become necessary.

CLASSIFICATION INFORMATION

PENALTY CLASSIFICATIONS:

SINGLES: At State/Provincial and the Grand Pacific Championships Tournaments all sub juniors, juniors, senior and elders who have not shot at a minimum of 300 PITA registered 16-yard targets during the current and previous year combined shall be classified not less than Class "A". All others, including veterans and ladies, must have 500 PITA registered 16-yard targets during the same period of time, or must be classified not less than Class "A".

DOUBLES: At State/Provincial and Grand Pacific Championship Tournaments all sub juniors, juniors, senior and elders who have not shot at a minimum of 100 PITA registered double targets during the current and previous year combined shall be classified not less than Class "B". All others, including veterans and ladies, must have 200 PITA registered double targets during the same period of time, or must be classified not less than Class "B".

HANDICAP: At State/Provincial and Grand Pacific Championship Tournaments, all shooters who have not shot at the below listed quantity of PITA registered handicap targets during the current and previous year combined shall be assigned yardage as follows (changed 11/1/2022):

Category	Quantity of PITA Targets	Minimum Assigned Penalty Yardage
Sub-Juniors	500	22 yards
Juniors	500	24 yards
Ladies	500	22 yards
Veterans	500	24 yards
Seniors	500	24 yards
Elders	500	24 yards
All Others	500	24 yards

The stated number of PITA registered targets may be satisfied by the substitution of a like number of registered ATA targets.
