RESTROOMS, SHOWERS & HANDWASHING

Portable restrooms and handwashing stations will be located throughout the grounds, primarily along the trap lines. Clubhouse restrooms and showers will also be available throughout the weekend.

TOW VEHICLES & EXTRA PARKING

Please keep tow vehicles within your assigned camping space whenever possible while still allowing room for traffic flow. Additional vehicle parking is available along the south fence line and west of the 5-Stand area.

Parking, Arrival & Practice

Parking & Arrival Procedures

Parking spaces directly behind each trap bank will be reserved for coaches.

Parents and teams may pull up near their assigned trap to unload shooters, firearms, and equipment. Once unloaded, please proceed to the designated parking area assigned to your trap group as shown on the event maps.

The asphalt parking lot directly south of the clubhouse will be reserved primarily for ADA parking.

Please review the event maps online prior to arrival.

Practice Information

Practice will be available Thursday from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM, Friday from 9:00 AM - 8:00 PM, Saturday beginning at 6:30 AM, and Sunday beginning at 6:30 AM.

Practice Pricing: \$7.00 per round (25 targets).

Saturday and Sunday Morning Practice: \$5.00 for 10 targets, 2 targets per post.

Teams wishing to practice on Thursday or Friday may stop by the clubhouse and we will help get you set up with individual practice rounds or assign a trap for team practice, subject to availability.

Clubhouse, Vendors & Trap Line

Clubhouse Information

Available in the clubhouse: Ice - \$5 per bag, Ammunition - \$10 per box.

We will not be providing the clubhouse Wi-Fi password during the event. In previous years, allowing several thousand devices onto the network has overwhelmed the system and impacted tournament operations.

Due to the size of this event, please limit clubhouse access to coaches, event staff, volunteers, and authorized personnel.

Food Vendors

We will have four food vendors located on the east side of the clubhouse serving food throughout the weekend.

Seating for meals and gathering will be available on the clubhouse front porch.

Trap Line Information

Each competition trap will be equipped with a sunshade canopy, picnic table, and additional spool-table gun rack for squad use.

Our goal is to have one hot loader assigned to each trap. Coaches should periodically check in with their loader throughout the day. This allows squads to continuously rotate through competition with minimal downtime and helps keep the tournament running on schedule.
